Apply For/Transfer Board/MLS Membership

As a licensed real estate agent and a member of Real, you must join your local realtor's association.

Once you join your local association, you will be added to the National Association of Realtors ("NAR"). For a general overview of joining an association, visit the <u>NAR's</u> website for helpful information.

When you joined Real, you should have indicated what local association and board you are a member of or wish to be a member. In order to be a member of any board or association, Real's broker must be a member of that board or association.

Your board or association will allow you to change your association either online or require you to complete a form. If you can make the changes online, follow the specific instructions of the association to get your license transferred to Real.

If your board or association requires you to complete a form, download the required form from the board or association's website and submit that form to our Support team. Our team will assist you with getting your board or association set up.
